The Balfour Project Fellowship Programme is a unique opportunity through advocacy and educational activities to raise awareness of Britain's historic and continuing responsibilities in Palestine and Israel.

The Balfour Project Fellowship programme offers Fellows many fantastic opportunities including:

- > **Advocating for Justice and Equal Rights:** The Balfour Project focuses on advocating for justice, security and equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis alike. By becoming a Fellow, you have the chance to contribute to the Balfour Project's efforts to raise public awareness and educate decision makers and the public on Britain's role in P/I.
- > **Expert Guidance and Training:** The programme offers comprehensive training and guidance from experts in the fields of international law, history, psychology of conflict, public speaking, campaigning, and event planning. This training equips Fellows with the necessary knowledge and skills to go on to be effective advocates for justice and equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis.
- > **Networking Opportunities:** Being part of the Fellowship programme provides access to a network of like-minded individuals, including alumni Fellows, mentors, and experts.
- > **Personal and Professional Development:** The programme offers a platform for personal and professional growth. Participants have the opportunity to enhance their understanding of Britain's role in P/I, develop advocacy skills, and gain practical experience in engaging with stakeholders and promoting just solutions.

The Balfour Project launched the first pilot Peace Advocacy Fellowship in 2019, since which there have been four further cohorts. The Fellowship programme is open to recent graduates (gap year), postgraduate or final year undergraduate students in the UK who are passionate about promoting equal rights for Palestinians and Israelis.

This year, we have adapted our programme to include two distinct pathways, as illustrated in the accompanying graphic. **Associate Fellows** will go through the training programme and work on a small-scale project. In addition, we are offering a small number of paid fellowships for those with experience in advocacy, education, or social media. These opportunities are: **Advocacy Fellow, Education Fellow, and Social Media Fellow**. They are distinguished from the Associate Fellows as they are specialised roles that will require more working hours on specific projects, for which there will be a small budget.
